This immersion weekend is aimed at supporting teachers to improve their Indonesian fluency in a semi or full immersion setting within a friendly, relaxed environment guided by expert background teachers of Indonesian. It is therefore highly recommended for teachers of Indonesian at any level.

Special guests from Dyatmika School in Bali, *Ibu Ayu, Ibu Utami* and Ibu Aprile will deliver sessions outlining the school-developed Indonesian Literacy Program and familiarise teachers with the outstanding resources developed by the school. These resources will be available for purchase.

Activities in the conversation sessions will be varied and interactive and incorporate the teaching and learning of intercultural understandings. During the weekend there will be opportunities for participants to be immersed in and experience various arts and cultures from across Indonesia.

There will be an emphasis on communication focused mainly on listening and responding with opportunities also for viewing, reading and responding in Indonesian. The direct teaching of grammar points will support the acquisition of communicative competence in Indonesian.

And there will be plenty of other surprises and activities during the weekend!

Ibu Aprile, Principal of the Primary School, will speak about the school based program 'Literasi Anak Indonesia', a Bahasa Indonesia literacy package created by the Dyatmika teachers.
